SAFETY GLASSES must be worn by ANYONE watching the demos or working at an open forge. Extra glasses will be available on-site.

Do this as soon as possible, allowing us to get an accurate count for the meals and time to have all the name tags prepared. Email address is requested for confirmation purposes. There will be NO phone confirmation.

Guests, spouses and children are welcome to join us as long as they are registered. No charge for children under 16.

TAILGATING: Starts at 3pm Friday. Remember to bring your surplus blacksmithing items to sell or swap. **We now have indoor tailgating space.**

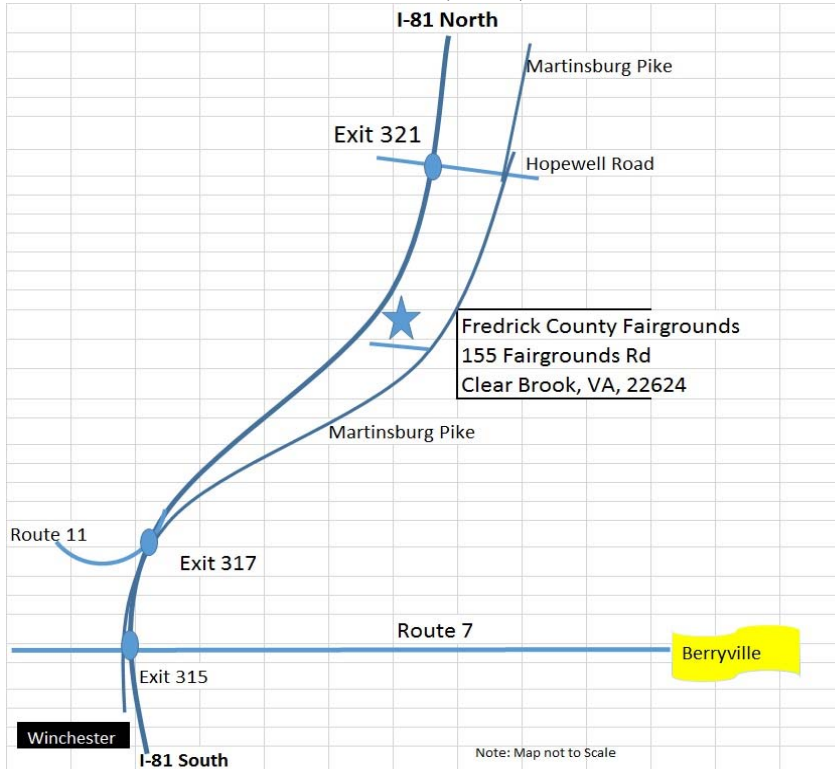

DIRECTIONS

From Washington DC

- Take I-66 West into Virginia
- Exit 1B, take ramp right for I-81 North toward Winchester
- Exit 317, take ramp right for VA-37 / US-11 toward Stephenson / Winchester
- Turn right onto US-11 N / VA-37 N / Martinsburg Pike
- 2.8 miles Turn left onto Fairground Rd

From the North

- Take I-81 South 7.8 miles into Virginia
- Exit 321, take ramp right toward Brucetown / Clearbrook.
- Turn left onto Hopewell Rd
- Turn right onto US-11 Martinsburg Pike
- Turn Right onto Fairground Rd

From the South

- Take I-81 North
- Exit 317, take ramp right for VA-37 / US-11 toward Stephenson / Winchester
- Turn right onto US-11 N / VA-37 N / Martinsburg Pike
- 2.8 miles Turn left onto Fairground Rd
